Now follow the instructions and answer the questions below.

Pause the film after 19 secs - when the film zooms in on the boy.

1. Is this boy from UK? How do you know?

2. What is the boy doing and how do you think he is feeling?

Pause the film after 41 seconds when we see the fish in the basket.

3. How is the boy feeling at this point and why do you think he is feeling like this?

4. How would you feel if you caught a fish?

5. How do we know that he needs to catch more fish?

6. Who do you think he needs to catch the fish for and how do you know this?

Pause at 52 seconds when he sees the fox.

7. How do we know that he is shocked to see the fox?

Pause after the fox steals his fish and we see his face at 1 minute 25 seconds.

8. How is the boy feeling? If we were writing about this how could we show this to our reader? What would you write?

9. What thoughts do you think are going through his head at this point?

Pause the film as the boy crawls through the dark passageway at 1 minute 27 seconds.

10. Why does the boy look back before entering?

11. How can we describe this tunnel using a simile?

If you need a prompt...

e.g. A tunnel as dark as..._____

Thorns as sharp as..._____

Pause when the boy reaches the top of the cliff at 2 mins 26 seconds.

12. Why do you think the fox is doing this for the boy?

Watch the film to the end

13. What do you think the boy is thinking when he sees the lake?

14. What happens to the fox at the end? What do you think the fox was?

Extension

Can you think of any questions you could ask?

The Catch Answers

As some of these answers are inference you might have answered slightly differently but if it is a similar response then 😊

1. The boy is not from the UK as in the film clip I can see the boy's village which is in a forest clearing. The homes are not made from the same material we build houses from in the UK. The little boy is also wearing trousers and hat and the sun is shining therefore I think it must be somewhere hot.
2. The boy is pleased to have caught the fish as he smiles as he pulls the fish from the water.
3. The boy is fishing but has only caught a small fish. He is sad and disappointed about his catch as his face is in a frown and his shoulders are low and he sighs. He looks at the village, which I think means he is catching food for the village and he knows there isn't enough fish to feed everyone.
4. I would feel..... because.....
5. We know he needs to catch more fish as he looks at the village sadly and the basket is very big suggesting that it needs to full to feed everyone.
6. The fish needs to be caught for the village. We know this as he looks at the village after he places the small fish in the basket.
7. We know he is shocked to see the fox as his eyes widen and he blinks a lot, as if he is checking that what he is seeing is right. His mouth also opens wide, as if he is in disbelief.
8. The boy is shocked that the fox has stolen his fish.
E.G. writing.
As the fox leapt away with his tiny fish the boy gasped in surprised, his eyes wide.
9. Why would the fox take my small fish after I helped him!
10. The boy looks back before entering because the village is safe and the path ahead looks dangerous, he might be unsure if he should follow the fox.

13. He is amazed and surprised. He might be thinking how could this be here and we never knew!
