This term our Topic is
the Tudors



Welcome back to school. I hope that you are all rested and looking forward to a busy and fun-filled Autumn term.

English: We will be looking at a range of different types of texts: narratives, historical narratives, diary writing, recounts and commentaries. As ever we will be improving our grammar, punctuation and spelling skills and ensuring that we apply these skills in our writing. We will also be working on our comprehension skills through written comprehension work and our oral comprehension during Guided Reading work.

Maths: We are continuing to build our mathematical skills through understanding place value, adding, subtracting, multiplying, dividing, fractions, decimals, telling the time and converting units of time.

Practical activities to do at home: please encourage your child to tell the time regularly and look at bus and train timetables when possible as these are skills for life.

Keep practicing your child's recall of their times tables and encourage them to go onto **Doodle Maths** (ideally daily) and **Doodle Maths Timestable** as it really does boost children's understanding and confidence in Maths.

Topic: We will be studying the Tudors.

Science: We will study the lifecycles of a variety of different species and we will be comparing them. We will then look at forces.

RE: We will be studying Christianity and what it means if God is loving and holy. We will be studying Hinduism and the way they show commitment to their faith.

ICT: We will be learning to create shapes in google drawings and video editing.

PSHE: We will be looking at being me and celebrating our differences.

French: We will be looking at how to talk about our local town, transportation, giving directions and numbers to 100.

PE: We will be doing invasion games and gymnastics.

ART/DT: We will be developing our drawing skills and learning to use different mediums to create a whole class piece. We will also design and construct Tudor houses.

Music: We will look at pulse, rhythm and pitch for rock and improvisation in jazz music
