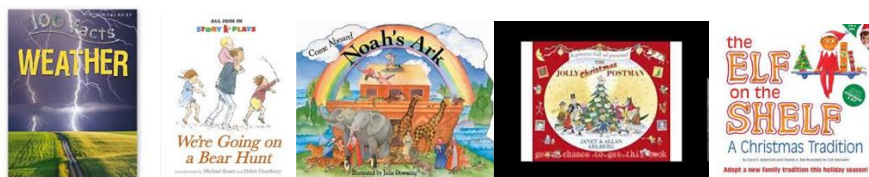


Reception Autumn 2 Term Newsletter

Welcome to the Autumn 2 term, this term we have an exciting new topic we are covering.



Topic: The Weather and Seasons



This term we will be exploring the topic of The Weather and seasons. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction books. From this we will learn about different types of weather such as tornadoes, floods and electrical storms. We will be doing activities such as making stain glass kites, making our own rainbows and painting Noah's Ark. We will also be learning about celebrations that take place during this term such as Bonfire night, Diwali, Remembrance day and Christmas.

Literacy:

This term we will be continuing to learn our phase 2 sounds and how to write simple words and sentences by blending sounds together in words and using finger spaces to separate these words. We will be writing weather reports, thinking about describing words, writing lists and adding words to story maps.

Maths:

This term we will be learning about the composition of numbers 4 and 5- what numbers bond together, addition and subtraction facts, subitising amounts and matching to numerals. We will also look at the relationship between one more and one less and learning all about quadrilaterals. Finally we will discuss night and day and the order that key events happen in their daily routine.
