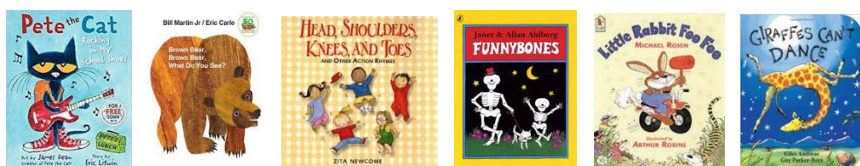


Spruce Autumn 1 Term Newsletter

Welcome to the Autumn 1 term, this term we have an exciting new topic we are covering.



Topic: Ourselves



This term we will be exploring the topic of Ourselves. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction books. From this we will learn about our new school, our bodies, our senses and what makes us unique. We will be doing activities such as making class books, experiments using our senses and making skeleton pictures.

Literacy:

This term we will be looking at the initial sounds letters make. We will begin to segment and blend individual sounds in words to prepare us for reading and writing and will begin to look at correct letter formations. We will also look at rhyming words.

Maths:

This term we will be exploring 1:1 counting and linking this to numbers. We will be practicing putting our numbers in the correct order and matching to quantities. We will be singing number rhymes to help children to understand the concept of a number, counting forwards and backwards.

Activities to do at home:

- Encourage children to talk positively about school. Discuss what they did today, who they played with etc
- Help children to understand the concept of number "can you get me three potatoes?"
- Help children to recognise numbers. For example, number their toy cars and ask them what number they are playing with today.
- Have a number of the week and help your child recognise it, write it, count out correct number of objects.
- Help children to write their names using correct letter formations. (Capital letter at the beginning only)
- Help children to hear initial sounds in words
- Read stories encouraging children to predict, recall, join in with refrains and guess the rhyming word.
