Welcome back to the summer term. This term we are covering some exciting topics.



English: We will continue our space topic, writing persuasive letters, sci-fi and persuasive stories. In the latter part of the term, we will be writing some more poetry.

Maths: This term we will be learning about volume and capacity and 2-D shapes. We will extend our knowledge of fractions by practicing the multiplication of fractions and whole numbers. In geometry, we will be looking at the rotation of shapes and in statistics the focus will be line graphs. We will revisit place value and the written methods of the four operations regularly.

To support your child in maths, please ensure that he/she can tell the time and please continue to practice times tables and number bonds as the fast recall of these facts helps the children in all areas of maths.

Topic: In history we will be looking at the history of space exploration and Mayan civilization.

Science: We will continue our space topic and will be studying reversible and irreversible changes in chemistry through practical and theoretical sessions.

RE: We will be studying more aspects of the Hindu faith in detail: Karma, Samsara and Moksha and we will be ending the year by investigating what is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God.
