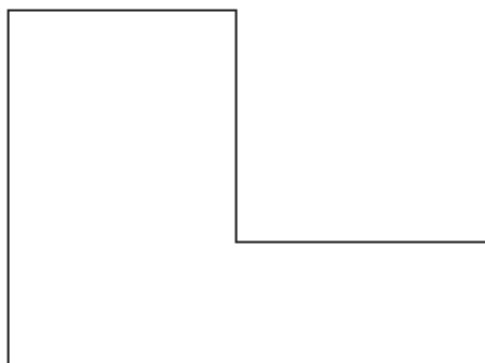

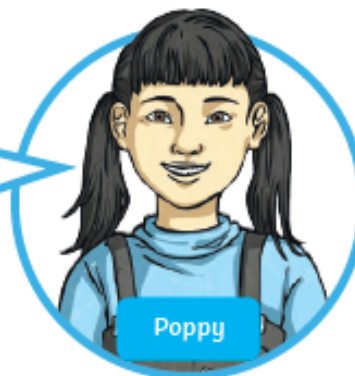


1) Draw 3 different compound shapes, each with an area of 45cm^2 .

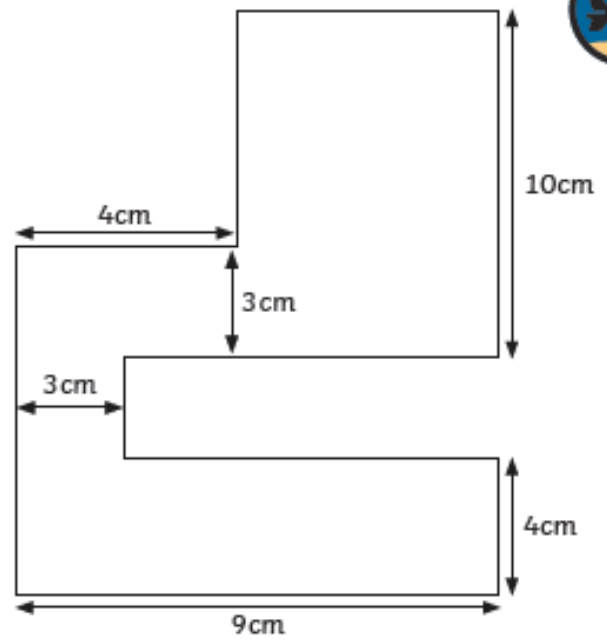
1) Ianto wants to calculate the area of this shape.
