Learn one sound a day and revise the sounds you have learnt. Listen to the video on how to correctly say the sound i,n,m,d. Listen and sing the i,n,m,d Jolly Phonics songs. Find objects in your house that begin with the sound you are learning. Practice blending on Phonics Play.





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Reading	Listening to story books	If you have run out of books at home you can use youtube. Choose a video where it displays the words and mute the sound and read to your child. Ask questions such as what do you think is going to happen? Look at the pictures and describe the events that are happening, the character and the setting. At the end ask what happened in the story?	Listen to at least one story book a day.
Writing	Copying letters, writing own name from memory and drawing.		To draw a picture of something you did last week. Under the drawing write/copy cvc words.
Maths	Counting and counting quantity.	Find a fun counting game on the website bellow. Some games are tablet friendly. However if you have a computer/laptop at home, using a mouse is a brilliant skill to learn. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/3-5-years/counting	Count to 20 every day, count in a silly voice, a loud voice, a quiet voice. Play a counting quantity game on top marks.
