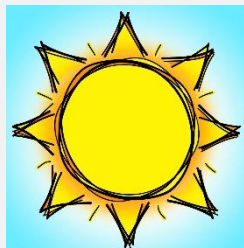


## Year 6 Summer Term Newsletter

Welcome back to the summer term, this term we have lots of exciting topics we are covering.



**We are looking forward to a very busy and fun-filled summer term.**

**English:** During Summer Term 1 we will continue to hone our grammar, punctuation and spelling skills, plus improving our comprehension skills for our SATs tests. After half term, we will be reading *The Final Year* by Matt Goodfellow and writing poetry based on the book.

**Maths:** We will focus on revision and embedding the curriculum knowledge through problem solving to prove what we know and improve our problem-solving skills.

**Practical activities to do at home:** please encourage your child to tell the time regularly and look at bus and train timetables when possible as these are skills for life.

Keep practising your child's recall of their times tables and encourage them to go onto Doodle Maths as it really does boost children's understanding of Maths.

**History:** In our first summer term we will be studying *The Cold War: How it was fought through proxy wars, the space and arms race*. During summer term 2 we will be learning about the history of human rights.

**Geography:** During summer term 1 we will be studying the continent of Africa and in summer term 2 we will be looking at globalization.

**PE:** During the Summer Term the Windsor Sports Partnership we will come in to teach Dance and Outdoor Adventurous Activities. We will also be practicing for Sports Day and our Striking and Fielding skills ready for the Year 6 vs Teachers rounders game.

**Science:** We are studying Reproduction in plants and animals and Evolution.

**Religion & Worldviews:** In the last two terms we will be looking at different religions to answer the questions: 'Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?' and 'What matters most to Humanists and Christians?'

**ICT:** We are learning more about programming and programming variables in a game. We will also be creating media using 3D modelling.

We will also be practicing for our musical and class assembly at the end of the academic year.
