Top tips for managing the summer holidays!

1. Try to stick to normal routines where possible and have key anchors in the day which remain the same —e.g. bedtime, wake up time etc.
2. Inform your child/children with a rough plan of the day. Try to pre-empt any changes ahead of time.
3. Allow plenty of time for free play and rest! The holidays do not need to be jam-packed as this can be overwhelming for children.
4. Get outside in nature as much as you can! :)
