Phonics

This term we will be teaching phase 1 phonics. The children will be learning to develop awareness of sounds and rhythms. To distinguish between sounds and to remember patterns of sound. To talk about sounds we make with our bodies and what the sounds mean.

This term, we will be sharing and enjoying the stories **Funnybones**, **Owl Babies**, and **Room on the Broom**. The children will listen to and talk about the stories, join in with repeated words and phrases, and take part in activities linked to the characters and events. These stories will help develop their listening, speaking, and early reading skills.
